Patriot Preparatory Academy Academic Goals

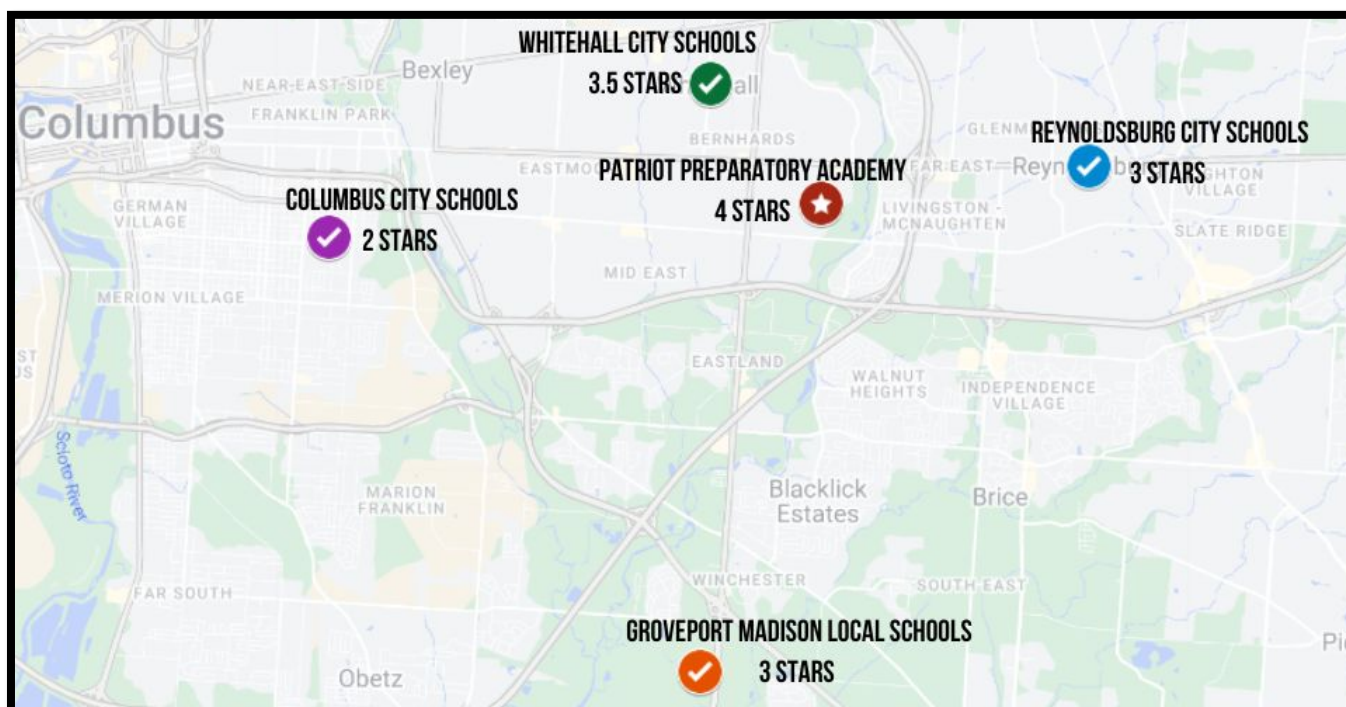
1. By June 30, 2025 we will improve the performance of all students, all grades at Patriot Preparatory Academy to increase 18% in math using State Report Card data.
2. By June 30, 2025 we will improve the performance of all students, all grades at Patriot Preparatory Academy to increase 14% in English Language Arts using State Report Card data.
3. By June 30, 2025, we will increase the participation and offered events by 100% to include parents and community stakeholders in activities at the school, so that there is understanding of the academic and behavior expectations of Patriot Preparatory Academy and the enrolled students.



Patriot Preparatory Academy Academic Achievements

- Graduating Class of 2024 – At our 14th commencement, our 25 graduating seniors had many accomplishments that should be highlighted!
 - Earned a combined total of 145 college credits while in high school
 - Earned a combined total of 182 graduation seals, with 96% of students earning more than the 2 required seals
 - Completed over 2,500 community service hours as a class while in high school
 - Received a combined total of \$1,077,280 in scholarships, grants, and financial awards
 - 100% accepted to a college of their choice

Sponsor's Statement

St. Aloysius, as the sponsor of this school, is legally mandated to provide oversight, monitoring, and technical assistance.
